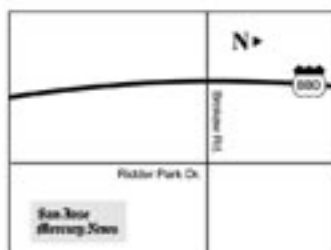
Public Tours



Thank you for your interest in a tour of the San Jose Mercury News

Tours are open to the community and are *free of charge*. Tours are very popular — the tour calendar often fills up three months in advance — so we recommend you book your date early. Below is some important information about the tour program:

- **TOUR DAYS:** Tuesday and Wednesday
- **TOUR TIME:** 10 a.m.
- **TOUR LENGTH:** 1-1½ hours
- **MINIMUM AGE:** Third-grade level
- **CHAPERONES:** 1 adult for every 5 children
- **MAXIMUM GROUP SIZE:** 30 (incl. chaperones)
